**SOME OF THE SUNNAN OF DHUL HIJJAH**

The Prophet ﷺ used to fast on the first nine days of Dhul Hijjah. It was narrated from Hunaydah ibn Khaalid from his wife, that one of the wives of the Prophet ﷺ said: The Prophet ﷺ used to fast on the first nine days of Dhul Hijjah and the day of 'Ashoora', and three days each month, the first Monday of the month and two Thursdays. Narrated by al-Nasaa'i, 4/205 and by Abu Dawood; classed as saheeh by al-Albaani in Saheeh Abi Dawood, 2/462.

It is Sunnah to recite alot of Takbeer ("Allaahu akbar"), Tahmeed ("Al-hamdu Lillaah"), Tahleel ("La ilaaha ill-Allaah") and Tasbeeh ("Subhaan Allaah") during the first ten days of Dhul Hijjah, and to say it loudly in the mosque, the home, the street and every place where it is permitted to remember Allaah and mention His name out loud, as an act of worship and as a proclamation of the greatness of Allaah, may He be exalted. Men should recite these phrases out loud, and women should recite them quietly.
